### RANGELAND/WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PROJECT

A rangeland/wildlife management field day was conducted in Medina County to disseminate technical information on conservation practices applicable on rangeland and the protection and enhancement of wildlife.

Agricultural producers heard from experts in brush control, integrated pest management, range seeding and wildlife management practices including censuring, watering facilities and wildlife food plots.

Over 100 agricultural producers attended the one-day event, which included hands on field demonstrations of the various practices.
