## WASTEWATER SYSTEMS PROJECT

Through a program of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) was granted. A \$250,000 grant was received to bring to code failing septic systems in rural Wilson County. News releases, both in English and Spanish, were sent to the local newspapers and radio stations with information about the program and how homeowners could apply. A form, rules, fact sheets and other information was made available to homeowners at the Alamo RC&D Office, NRCS Office in Floresville, and the Wilson County Courthouse during a set signup period.

Working together with personnel from Wilson County, the San Antonio River Authority and Alamo RC&D 53 applications were reviewed. A total of 38 septic systems were upgraded.
